

Supplies used:

- Rayon embroidery thread
- Curved double edge scissors
- Wash-away stabilizer (2 pieces)
- Garment of your choice
- Cutwork Lace design (6.10"w X 3.67"h)



Step 1

Print out the design template. Cut a small hole in the center of the template. Pin the template to your garment where you want the design to be. Mark the center



Step 2

Snip a small hole in the garment.



Step 3

Hoop 2 pieces of wash-away stabilizer and your garment. Keep the template pinned to the garment.



Step 4

Line up the needle directly over the center/center point.



Step 5

Remove the template. Sew the guide line. Remove from machine.



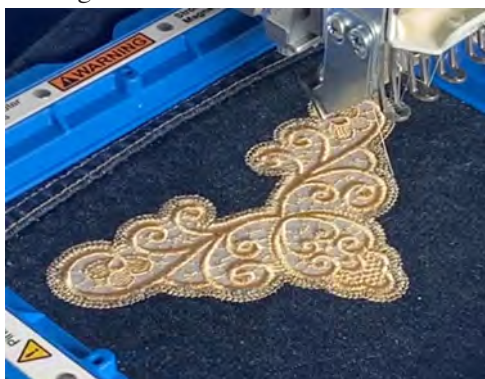
Step 6

Use the small hole in the garment to slip your scissors into and cut away the fabric inside the guide line.



Step 7

Place back on the machine and finish sewing the lace.



Step 8

Remove from hoop and trim away the excess stabilizer.



Step 9

Using hot water and a sponge or run under a tap, wash away the stabilizer.
