

Supplies used:

- Embroidery thread
- 5"x7" hoop
- No-show mesh stabilizer
- Tape (painters tape or similar)
- Double edge curve scissors
- 2 pieces of 5"x7" fabric (1 top appliqué, 1 base fabric which will be the border)
- 2 back fabric pieces 5"x8" each folded in half length wise



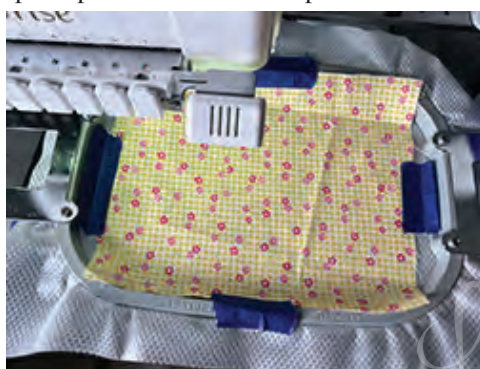
Step 1

Hoop stabilizer and run the first placement stitch for base fabric.



Step 2

Place the base fabric face up over the stitches. Tape in place. Run tack and placement stitches.



Step 3

Place top appliqué fabric over placement stitch and run tack stitch.



Step 4

Remove hoop and trim appliqué fabric close to stitches.



Step 5

Place hoop back on machine. Run zigzag around appliqué fabric, embroider design, stipple, satin appliqué stitch, motif and blanket decorative stitches.



Step 6

Run the placement stitch for the first back fabric piece.



Step 7

Remove hoop. Lay first back fabric piece down lining up the fold edge to the "tabs" on the placement stitch. Tape into place.



Step 8

Place hoop back on machine. Run triple pass tack down stitch.



Step 9

Run the second placement stitch for the second back fabric piece.



Step 10

Remove hoop. Lay second back fabric piece down lining up the fold edge to the “tabs” on the placement stitch. Back fabric pieces should overlap. Tape into place.



Step 11

Place hoop back on machine. Run triple pass tack down stitch and finishing running stitch around design.



Step 12

Remove project from the hoop and cut excess fabric from around the Mug Rug.



Step 13

Turn inside out.
